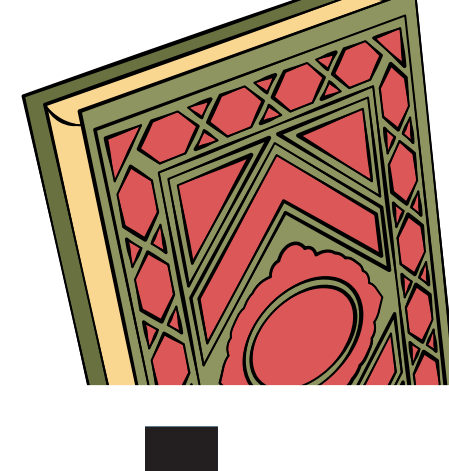


# 100 most common verbs in the Quran
