Namaaz

Oh mankind! Worship your Lord who has created you and those who have gone before you, so that you may guard yourselves against evil.

(Surah al-Baqarah, 2:21)

Namaz has ten qualities:

It is a pillar of faith; it beautifies the face; it illuminates the heart; it comforts the body; it is a friend in the grave; it causes the mercy of Allah to descend; it is a celestial light; it is a weight attached to the balance; it brings the pleasure of Allah; it is the price of paradise and it is a barrier to hell. He who establishes it, establishes faith and he who forsakes it, demolishes faith.

(The Holy Prophet S.A.W.W.)

Be particular about Namaaz and be punctual in offering it. Offer Namaaz as you can and seek the nearness of Allah by means of it, for Namaaz at appointed hours is obligatory on the faithful.

(Imam Ali ibn-e-Abi Talib A.S.)

Adhan (Call for Namaaz)

As soon as the time for namaaz draws near, the adhan is recited aloud in every masjid. It is highly desirable to recite the adhan which is as under:

Say 4 times:

الله أكبَرُ ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great

Say 2 times:

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لا إِلهَ إِلّاللّٰهُ ASHHAD-U AN LĀ ILĀH-A ILLĀLLĀH I bear witness that there is no god but Allah

Say 2 times:

أَشَهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ الله ASHHAD-U ANNA MUHAMMAD-AN RASŪLULLĀH

I bear witness that Muhammad is the messenger of Allah

Say 2 times:

أَشْهَدُ أَنَّ عَليّاً وَٰلِيُّ الله

ASHHAD-U ANNÄ ALĪ-YYAN WALĪ-YYULLĀH I bear witness that Ali is the vicegerent of Allah

Say 2 times:

حَيَّ على الصَّلاة HAYYA 'ALĀS-SALĀH Hasten toward prayer

Say 2 times:

حَيَّ على الفَلاح HAYYA 'ALĀ L-FALĀH Hasten toward salvation

Say 2 times:

حَيَّ على خَيْرِ العَمَل HAYYÁ 'ALĀ KHAYRIL 'AMAL Hasten toward the best of deeds

Say 2 times:

الله أكبَر ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great

Say 2 times:

لا إلهُ إلّااللهُ LA ILĀH-A ILLĀLLĀH There is no god but Allah

Iqaamah (Introduction for Namaaz)

After adhan one should stand erect, alert and attentive to begin the namaaz, facing qiblah. Declaration for the standing of namaaz is called iqaamah which is as under:

Say 2 times:

الله أكبَر ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great

Say 2 times:

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لا إِلهَ إِلّااللّٰهُ ASHHAD-U AN LĀ ILĀH-A ILLĀLLĀH I bear witness that there is no god but Allah

Say 2 times:

أَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ الله

ASHHAD-U ANNA MUḤAMMAD-AN RASŪLULLĀH I bear witness that Muhammad is the messenger of Allah

Say 2 times:

أَشْهَدُ أَنَّ عَلِيّاً وَٰ إِيُّ اللّٰه

ASHHAD-U ANNÄ ALĪ-YYAN WALĪ-YYULLĀH I bear witness that Ali is the vicegerent of Allah

Say 2 times:

حَيَّ على الصَّلاة HAYYA 'ALĀS-SALĀH Hasten toward prayer

Say 2 times:

حَيَّ على الفَلاح HAYYA 'ALĀ L-FALĀH Hasten toward salvation

Say 2 times:

حَيَّ على خَيْرِ العَمَلِ HAYYÁ 'ALĀ KHAYRIL 'AMAL Hasten toward the best of deeds

Say 2 times:

قَدْ قامَت الصّلاة QAD QĀMAT-IŞ-ŞALĀH The prayer has certainly been established

Say 2 times:

الله أكبَر ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great

Say 1 time:

لا إلهُ إلّاللُهُ LA ILĀH-A ILLĀLLĀH There is no god but Allah

Namaaz

The namaaz time and its rak'ats (units):

1. Namaaz-e Fajr (Dawn Prayer)	2 rak'at
2. Namaaz-e Dhohr (Noon Prayer)	4 rak'at
3. Namaaz-e 'Asr (Afternoon Prayer)	4 rak'at
4. Namaaz-e Maghrib (Dusk Prayer)	3 rak'at
5. Namaaz-e Isha (Night Prayer)	4 rak'at

Niyyah

Say or have in mind, the intention (niyyah) of the namaaz you are offering, for example:

(1)

l offer two rak'at Namaaz-e Fajr Wajib Qurbatan Ilallah (Seeking nearness to Allah, in obedience to Him)

(2)

l offer four rak'at Namaaz-e Dhohr Wajib Qurbatan llallah (Seeking nearness to Allah, in obedience to Him)

(3)

I offer four rak'at Namaaz-e 'Asr Wajib Qurbatan Ilallah (Seeking nearness to Allah, in obedience to Him) (4)

I offer three rak'at Namaaz-e Maghrib Wajib Qurbatan Ilallah (Seeking nearness to Allah, in obedience to Him)

(5)

l offer four rak'at Namaaz-e Isha Wajib Qurbatan Ilallah (Seeking nearness to Allah, in obedience to Him)

After the Niyyah, perform **Takbeeratul Ihram**

Raise both hands to the ears and say once:

الله أكبَر ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great

First Rak'at

Qiyam (Standing Position)



Recite Surah Al-Fatiha once:

بِسْمِ ٱللَّٰهِ ٱلرَّحْمَٰنِ ٱلرَّحِيمِ BISMILÁHÍR-RAHMAÁNIR-RÁHEEM In the Name of Allah - the Most Compassionate, the Most Merciful

ٱلْحَمْدُ للَّه رَبِّ ٱلْعَـٰلَمِينَ ALHAMDU LÍLLAAHI RÁBBIL 'AALAMEEN All praise is for Allah - cherisher Lord of all the worlds

ٱلرَّحْمَـٰن ٱلرَّحِيمِ AR-RAHMAAŃIR-RAHEEM The Most Compassionate, the Most Merciful

> مـٰلك يَوْم ٱلدِّين MAAĹIKI YÁWMÍĎ-DEEN Master of the Day of Judgment

إِيَّاكَ نَعْبُدُ وَإِيَّاكَ نَسْتَعِينُ IYYAAKA NA'BUDU WA IYYAAKA NASTA'EEN You alone we worship and You alone we ask for help

> ٱهْدنَا ٱلصِّرَٰطَ ٱلْمُسْتَقِيمَ IHDINAS-SIRAATAL-MUSTAQEEM Guide us along the Straight Path,

صِرِٰطَ ٱلَّذِينَ أَنْعَمْتَ عَلَيْهِمْ غَيْرِ ٱلْمَغْضُوبِ عَلَيْهِم وَلَا ٱلضَّالِّينَ

SIRAATAL-LADHEENA AN'AMTA 'ALAIHIM GHAYRIL-MAGHDHOOBI 'ALAIHIM WA LAD-DHAAALI FFN

The path of those whom You have blessed — not the path of those You inflicted with Your wrath nor gone astray

After Surah Al-Fatiha, recite Surah Al-Ikhlas once:

بِسْمِ ٱللَّٰهِ ٱلرَّحْمَٰنِ ٱلرَّحِيمِ BISMILÁHÍR-ŔAHMAÁNIR-RÁHEEM In the Name of Allah - the Most Compassionate, the Most Merciful

> قُلْ هُوَ ٱللَّهُ أَحَدُّ QUL HUWAL LAAHU AHAD Say, "He, Allah is One"

> > ٱللَّهُ ٱلصَّمَدُ ALLAH HUS-SAMAD Allah - the Needless

لَمْ يَلِدْ وَلَمْ يُولَدْ LAM YALID WA LÁM YOOLAD He neither begat, nor was He begotten

وَلَمْ يَكُن لَّهُ كُفُوًا أَحَد WA LAM YAKUL-LAHOO KUFUWAN AHAD And there is none comparable to Him

Now raise both hands to the ears and say once ALLĀH-U AKBAR, then go to rukoo'

Rukoo' (Bowing Position)



Recite once:

سُبْحانَ رَبِّ الْعَظيمِ وَ بِحَمْدِه SUBHAN-A RABBI-AL-'AZIM-I WA BI-HAMDIH Glory be to my cherisher Lord, The Holy, with His praise

ٱللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ مُحَمَّد وْ آلِ مُحَمَّد ALLĀHUMMA ṢAĹLI ʿĀLĀ MUḤAMMADIN WA ĀALI MUḤAMMAD

O My Lord! Send blessings on Muhammad and on the descendents of Muhammad

After recitation of the dhikr of rukoo', stand and recite once:

سَمعَ اللَّهُ لِمَنْ حَمِدَهُ SAMI'ALLÁHU LÍMAN ÁAMIDAH Allah hears whosoever glorifies Him

Now raise both hands to the ears and say once ALLĀH-U AKBAR, then go to sajdah

Sajdah

(Prostration)



Recite once:

سُبْحانَ رَبِّ الْاَعلٰي وَ بِحَمْدِه SUBHAN-A RABBI-AL-A'LA-WA BI-HAMDIH Glory be to my cherisher Lord, The Highest, with His praise

ٱللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ مُحَمَّد وٰ آل مُحَمَّد ALLĀHUMMA ṢÁLLI 'ĀLĀ MUḤAMMADIN WA ĀALI MUḤAMMAD

O My Lord! Send blessings on Muhammad and on the descendents of Muhammad

After sajdah sit up, say ALLĀH-U AKBAR, then recite once:

أَسْتَغْفِرُ ٱللَّٰهَ رَبِّي وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْهِ ASTAĠFIRŪ-ĹLĀHA RABBĪ WĀ-ATŪBU ILAYH Verily, I seek the forgiveness of Allah, who is my cherisher Lord and I turn to Him in repentance

Say ALLĀH-U AKBAR then go to the second sajdah. Recite the same dhikr as the first sajdah

After the second sajdah sit up, say ALLĀH-U AKBAR, then stand up saying:

بحول الله وقوته أقوم وأقعد BI-HAW-LILLAHI WA QUWWATIHI AQUMU WA AQU'D By the power of Allah and His strength I rise and I sit

Second Rak'at

Qiyam

(Standing Position)

After Surah Al-Fatiha, recite Surah Al-Ikhlas once

In the second rak'at it is desirable (but optional) to say once:

كذك الله ربى KADHAALIKA-LLAHU RABBI Such is Allah, my cherisher Lord

Note: Kadhaalika-Ilahu-Rabbi is only recited after Surah Al-Ikhlas, but not otherwise. (Once, twice or three times)

Then raise both hands to the ears and say once ALLĀH-U AKBAR, then perform qunoot

Qunoot (Supplication)



Recite once:

رَبَّنا آتِنا فِي الدُّنْيا حَسَنَةً وَ فِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَ قِنا عَذابَ النَّار

RABBANA ATINA FI D-DUNYA HASANAT-AN WA FIL-AKHIRATI HASANATAN WA QINA 'ADHAB-AN-NAR

Our Lord, give us good in this world and good in the Hereafter, and save us from the punishment of the Fire

ٱللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ مُحَمَّد وٰ آل مُحَمَّد ALLĀHUMMA ṢAĹLI ʿĀLĀ MUḤAMMADIN WA ĀALI MUHAMMAD

O My Lord! Send blessings on Muhammad and on the descendents of Muhammad

Generally the above dua is recited in qunoot, but any dua from the Holy Qur'an can be recited

After qunoot remain standing, say ALLĀH-U AKBAR, then do the rukoo' and sajdah

Rise from sajdah, remain seated and say ALLĀH-U AKBAR

Sitting Position



Sitting position between two sajdahs, and when reciting tashahhud and salaam

While still sitting recite once:

ٱلْحَمْدُ لِلَّٰه AL-ḤẮMDU LILLĀH Praise be to Allah

Tashahhud

(Declaration of Faith)

Remain seated as you recite the following:

اَشْهَدُ اَنْ لاالهَ الاَّ اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لاشَرِيكَ لَهُ، وَاَشْهَدُ اَنَّ مُحَمَداً عَبْدُهُ وَ رَسُولُه، اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلى مُحَمَّد وَ آل مُحَمَّد

ASHHADU AN-LA ILAHA ILLALLAH, WAHDAHU LA SHAREEK-ALLAH, WA ASHHADU ANNA MUHAMMAD-AN ABDUHU WA RASULUH. ALLAHUMMA SALLI 'ALA MUHAMMADIN WA AALI MUHAMMAD

I bear witness that there is no god except Allah who is one without any partner, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger. O Allah! Bless Muhammad and the family of Muhammad

Salaam

(Salutation)

Remain seated as you recite the following:

اَلسَّلامُ عَلَيْكَ اَيُّهَا النَّيُّ وَ رَحْمَةُ اللّهِ وَ بِرَكاتُهُ، اَلسَّلامُ عَلَيْنا وَ عَلى عِبادِ اللّهِ الصَّالِحينَ، اَلسَّلامُ عَلَيكُمْ وَ رَحْمَةُ اللّهِ وَ بَرَكاتُهُ

AS-SALAMU 'ALAYK-A AYYUHAN-NABIYYU WA RAHMATU-LLAH-I WA BARAKATUH, AS-SALAMU 'ALAYNA WA 'ALA 'IBADIL-LLAHI SSALIHEEN, AS-SALAMU 'ALAYKUM WA RAHMAT-UL-ALLAH-I WA BARAKATUH

Peace be upon you O the Prophet, and the mercy of Allah and His bounties be upon you too, peace be upon us and upon the virtuous servants of Allah, peace be upon you all, and the mercy of Allah and His bounties be upon you all too

After the salaam raise both hands to the ears three times and recite each time:

اللَّهُ أَكبَر ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great Prayers of two rak'at (such as Namaaz-e Fajr) are ended after the salaam.

For prayers with more than two rak'at do not recite the salaam - instead, after the recitation of tashahhud stand up for the third rak'at saying:

بحول الله وقوته أقوم وأقعد BI HAW LILLAHI WA QUWWATIHI AQUMU WA AQU'D By the power of Allah and His strenath I rise and I sit

Third Rak'at

Qiyam

(Standing Position)

In qiyam instead Surah Fatiha and Ikhlas, recite the Tasbihaatul Arbaa' 3 times

Tasbihaatul Arbaa'

(Four Praises)

سُبْحانَ اللّهِ وَ الْحَمْدُ لِلّهِ وَ لاإِلهَ إِلَّا اللّهُ وَ اللّهُ أَكْبَرُ

SUBHAN ALLAHI WAL-HAMD-U LILLAHI WA LA ILAH-A ILLA ALLAHU WA-LLAH-U AKBAR

Glory be to Allah, and all praise belong to Allah and there is no god but Allah and Allah is Great

After the qiyam perform rukoo' and sajdah, followed by the tashahhud and salaam to complete 3 rak'ats (Namaaz-e Maghrib)

Fourth Rak'at

The fourth rak'at is offered in Namaaz-e Dhohr, 'Asr and Isha. Pray the fourth rak'at exactly as the third one and complete your namaaz with tashahhud and salaam It is highly recommended to recite the following tasbih after completing every namaaz

Tasbih-e Zahra (a.s)

Say 34 times:

اللهُ أُكبَرُ ALLĀH-U AKBAR Allah is Great

Say 33 times:

ٱلْحَمْدُ لِلَهُ AL-ḤẮMDU LILLĀH Praise be to Allah

Say 33 times: سُبْحَانَ ٱللَّه SUBদAAN ALLAAH Glory be to Allah بِسْمِ ٱللَّهِ ٱلرَّحْمَٰنِ ٱلرَّحِيمِ رَضِيتُ بِالله رَبَّا ، وَبِمُحَمَّد صلى الله عليه وآله نَبِيّا ، وَبِالاِسْلامِ دينا ، وَبِالقُرْآنِ كِتَاباً وَبِالكَعْبَةِ قَبْلَةً ، وَبِعَلِيٍّ وَلِيَّا وإِماماً ، وَبِالحَسَنِ وَالحُسَيْنِ وَعَلِيِّ ابْنَ الحُسَيْنِ وَمُحَمَّد بْنِ عَلِيٍّ وَجَعْفَر بْنِ مُحَمَّد وَمُوسى بْنَ جَعْفَر ، وَعَلِيِّ بْنِ مُوسى وَمُحَمَّد بْنِ عَلِيٍّ ، وَعَلِيِّ بْنِ مُحَمَّد وَالحَسَن بْنِ عَلِيٍّ وَالحُجَّة بْنِ الحَسَنِ صَلواتُ الله عَلَيْهِمْ أَنَّمَّةً. اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّ رَضِيتُ بِهِمْ أَنَّمَّةً فَارْضِنِي لَهُمْ إِنَّكَ عَلى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ
